

Things you might want to know: How do tropicals and exotics differ from hardier trees in growth and styling? How do you grow these trees from small material into bonsai?

Also, questions will be fielded from the audience, so bring along any questions you have.

If you have an unusual tropical (no ficus, please) we encourage you to bring it to the meeting for display.

Some Ficus Retusa Tiger Bark will be available for purchase at \$30. Very healthy, good looking trees from Florida.

Folks who took the Beginner Workshop last September, remember that there is a repotting session for you (and anyone else who wants help repotting) at Boerner Saturday July 25 from 9-12. Beginners bring your trees and pots, all else will be provided for you. Anyone else wishing to repot, please bring all of your own materials (soil, pots, wire, etc).

#### When checking in please bring:

- + your list of scientific names and common names,
- + the approximate age of the tree,
- + stand, accent, sketch of display, and the proposed style of tree.

HAVING A PICTURE OF YOUR SET-UP IS RECOMMENDED!!

It is also wise to mark all components of your display with your name.

(an address sticker is usually adequate)

Note: If the drop off/pick up schedule is not good for you, please make personal arrangements for your trees with someone who will care for them. YOU must alert the crew about these arrangements so trees will not be misdirected, lost or stolen.

#### **Bonsai Conventions**

**Bonsai Conventions** give bonsai enthusiast the opportunity to participate in bonsai activities. The educational workshops and demonstrations at bonsai gatherings are substantive and interesting. The programs are varied in location, content and skill level. You can participate in one or more workshops geared for beginner, intermediate, or advanced ability. Many workshops include bonsai material.

Participants are a group of people who have a passion for bonsai, learning and a sense of adventure. Programs and participants promote a friendly and social atmosphere from registration to the closing of the convention. You'll be surprised how quickly you make new friends.

A convention lasts two to three nights, usually starting on a Thursday afternoon with registration, and ending on Sunday after lunch. Many meals are provided and there could be 3 or 4 hours of demonstrations each day.

Workshops are usually held on Friday morning and afternoon. They consist of small groups usually around 8 and the instructor. The workshop fee is in addition to the symposium and is determined by the cost of material if provided and the visiting instructor. Early evenings often include field trips or social activities.

Bonsai Conventions are usually hosted by a member club or organization and provide unique programs developed by their members, and are open for all enthusiastic learners regardless of previous bonsai experience. In addition, most Bonsai Conventions are governed by their own members, and have members leading some of the workshops.


